Set up the Solar System dartboard by pinning it onto your targets and get your Space Adventurers into teams.



Get each Space Adventurer, or team, to pick an astronaut as their space mascot who they will represent when dashing around the Solar System dartboard. Will it be the fearless Pink Phantom, prankster Hubble Trouble, quick as-a-flash Max Speed or super smart inventor Snowball?



Each astronaut's mission is to reach zero from a starting point of 50. Wherever the arrow lands, subtract the points value from 50 eg if the arrow lands on Saturn, subtract 13 from 50.
